

## **We Need You!**

**Did you know that our School could be missing an additional £1480 of funding to help your child succeed?**

### **What is Pupil Premium funding?**

'Pupil Premium' funding is additional funding for schools to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupil of all abilities, to close the gaps between them and their peers. If your child is eligible, they will receive funding for the next **six** years. Therefore, these extra funds could make an ENORMOUS difference to the quality of education that we offer. Money could provide extra resources and teaching support for your child, pay towards breakfast and extra-curricular clubs, help fund trips or buy uniform. Schools decide how the money is spent.

There is also an '**Early Years Pupil Premium**' of £300 available to children in Nursery

### **Is my child eligible?**

All children from Reception to Yr2 (inclusive) are entitled to a Free school Meal (FSM) however your child can get an **FSM** (free school meal from Reception to Yr6) and could be eligible for Pupil Premium if you, your partner, or child is in receipt of one of the following:

Income Support

Universal Credit\*not earning more than £7,400.

Income Based Job seekers Allowance.

Income Related Employment and Support Allowance

Guaranteed Credit element of State Pension Credit

Support from National; Asylum Support Service (NASS)

Support from Local Authority SS Asylum Team (SSAT)

Child Tax Credit \*earning less than £16, 190 per annum.

Working Tax Credit \*four weeks after your employment ends

Your child is 'Looked After,' adopted from care or under a 'Special Guardianship Order'.

Your child is a 'Service (military) Child'.

### **How do I apply?**

Please apply online via the link on our website. You will need to provide your own details and those of your \*child and your National Insurance Number or National Asylum Seekers Number.

\*If you have more than one child, you will need to apply individually.
